DAY-WISE ITINERARY

DAY 1: KOLKATA - COPENHAGEN

MEAL ON BOARD – DINNER

Greetings from **GO everywhere** Holidays - the one-stop provider for all your travel needs and requirements. Assemble at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport 3 hours prior to departure. Our courteous and experienced Tour Manager, who will accompany you on the tour, will assist you to complete the formalities before boarding your flight to Copenhagen from Kolkata Airport.

On arrival at Copenhagen, complete all your immigration formalities and board the luxurious coach waiting for you to take you around the city for a guided orientation comprising major photostopic landmarks namely the **Kongens Nytorv**, the **Royal Theatre**, the colorful **Nyhavn harbor**, **Amalienborg Castle**, **Gefion Fountain**, the famous **Little Mermaid statue**, and the historic canal district, home to the **National Museum**, **Stock Exchange**, and **Christiansborg Castle**. A visit to **Tivoli Gardens**, a beloved amusement park founded in 1843, adds to the experience. Located in the heart of the city, Tivoli offers over 30 rides, beautiful gardens, concert venues, shops, and a variety of dining options. It has captivated visitors for generations, including Hans Christian Andersen and Walt Disney. After the tour, head to an Indian restaurant for dinner before settling in for an overnight stay at your hotel in Copenhagen.

DAY 2: COPENHAGEN - NUUK

BREAKFAST – DINNER

Today we take breakfast and check out. Taking our flight from Copenhagen, we fly into Nuuk- the Capital of Greenland. Once we arrive in this country, which is an eternal abode of ice, we transfer to our hotel. We check in at the scheduled time and spend some time at leisure before joining an exciting Northern Lights trip in the evening.

The moment you leave Nuuk behind, the noise, the glow, and the rush of the day soften. Ahead lies a quiet, open darkness, the kind that reveals more than it hides. Within minutes, the city becomes a distant warmth on the horizon. The tour is planned carefully based on weather and solar forecasts, giving you the best chance of seeing the aurora. *Nothing is promised*; that is the nature of the northern lights, but everything about this journey is designed to create the best possible conditions for nature to surprise.

Something special happens when the aurora moves through a moonlit sky: the colours glide more slowly, form wider shapes, and appear almost sculpted against the light.

Later, post-dinner, we spent the night in the comfort of the hotel.

DAY 3: NUUK

BREAKFAST – DINNER

Today after breakfast we proceed to sail through the frozen world as we take a seat in a 2 hrs Arctic Fjord Cruise through the Nuuk Fjord – The 2nd largest fjord system in the world, This two-hour Arctic Fjord Cruise is designed for guests who want to experience the fjord, the mountains, and the stillness of the Arctic without rushing.

As you leave the harbor, you pass the colonial waterfront before entering the fjord itself. The mountains rise higher, the water grows darker, and the landscape begins to unfold.

Even on a compact tour, no two journeys are the same. Ice drifts with wind and currents, light changes constantly, and the fjord reveals itself differently each day. Your captain chooses the route and pace based on conditions, ensuring the best possible experience within the two-hour window.

Along the way, your guide shares insight into life in the fjord - how nature, weather, ice, and seasons shape everyday life in Greenland.

Post the tour we enjoy some free time in the Greenlandic capital. Later, post dinner we get into the coach to chase the brilliant Aurora flashing in the sky (weather permitting), and finally we return to the hotel for a comfortable overnight stay.

DAY 4: NUUK

BREAKFAST – DINNER

Post breakfast we start another day filled with fun and excitement. The day is devoted to experiencing the cultural essence of Greenland, beginning with an orientation walk through the charming city of Nuuk. As the capital and the northernmost capital city in the world, Nuuk offers a fascinating blend of ancient traditions and modern Arctic life. Walking through the city allows you to absorb the atmosphere of this unique destination, where colourful houses stand against dramatic landscapes of mountains, fjords, and icy waters. The journey through Nuuk provides a glimpse into the everyday life of the local people, their traditions, and the resilient spirit that defines life in the Arctic. The walk takes you through Nuuk's historic Old District, one of the most picturesque and culturally significant parts of the city. Here, you will find traditional wooden buildings that date back centuries, standing as reminders of Greenland's colonial past. Overlooking the harbour stands the statue of Hans Egede, the Danish-Norwegian missionary often regarded as the founder of modern Nuuk. From this vantage point, the view of the harbour is breathtaking, with fishing boats gently moving across the cold Arctic waters and the surrounding mountains creating a dramatic natural backdrop. The scene perfectly captures the essence of Greenland—remote, powerful, and deeply connected to nature.

We further continue to the visit to the Nukk Museum that showcases Greenlandic history, art, and Inuit culture.

Later, we enjoy some good free time in the city centre for shopping and own entertainment, followed by dinner and stay in the hotel.

DAY 5: NUUK – KANGERLUSSUAQ

BREAKFAST – DINNER

Today we take a flight to Kangerlussuaq, a remote Arctic settlement that serves as one of Greenland's most important inland gateways. Nestled deep within a landscape of dramatic wilderness, Kangerlussuaq is surrounded by vast tundra plains, distant ice formations, and untouched Arctic scenery that stretches endlessly toward the horizon. The region offers a unique glimpse into Greenland's raw natural beauty, where the silence of nature and the crisp Arctic air create a truly unforgettable atmosphere. Upon arrival, travellers are welcomed by the serene surroundings and the striking contrast between the rugged terrain and the immense skies above.

Next the journey continues till Point 660 where you will have the chance to stand on the edge of the Greenland Ice Sheet and enjoy a panoramic view of the surrounding landscape. It's a perfect spot to capture stunning photographs and experience the raw,

untouched beauty, this area is known for.

You will continue towards the magnificent Russell Glacier. Here, you'll have the opportunity to get close to the impressive ice mass, which dates back to the ancient Ice Age. The glacier is one of the most remarkable in the area. After a hike, you will reach the front of the Russell Glacier, which rises up to 60 meters in some places. You'll find many excellent spots for close-up shots and panoramic photographs.

This tour will involve good walking through the Greenlandic Ice sheet. Post the tour we take a delicious dinner and again set out to hunt the Aurora shimmering across the darkness, with ribbons of green, violet, and sometimes pink waves illuminating the night sky (*weather permitting*).

We finally bring the day to an end by sleeping comfortably in our hotel.

DAY 6: KANGERLUSSUAQ - ILULISSAT

BREAKFAST – DINNER

After enjoying breakfast, you will proceed to the airport to board your flight to Ilulissat, one of the most breathtaking destinations in the Arctic and a place renowned for its dramatic natural beauty. This charming town is home to the

famous Ilulissat Icefjord, a spectacular glacial fjord designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its extraordinary geological and environmental significance. As your flight approaches the town, you may catch glimpses of the vast Arctic landscape, where endless fields of ice and towering icebergs create a scene unlike anywhere else on Earth.

On arrival we have the afternoon free at leisure to admire the virgin beauty of this place. Later we take up the Icefjord Cruise through the **Sermeq Kujalleq**. Every day, millions of tonnes of ice flow from the glacier through Ilulissat Icefjord (Kangia) and into **Disko Bay**. The result is huge icebergs that majestically soar high above sea level. At the mouth of the ice fjord, these giants are stranded, so here you have the opportunity to sail around the icebergs and admire their beauty.

The icebergs are an impressive sight in all kinds of weather. In the sunshine its the contrasts, in cloudy weather the blue shades emerge very beautifully, and in the low rays of the evening sun, the Icebergs are painted a unique hue, which entices visitors back to Ilulissat to experience it again.

Next we check into the hotel. By night, we finish our dinner early and set out to chase the Northern Light from Ilulissat . The day concludes with a comfortable overnight stay, allowing you to rest and prepare for more unforgettable Arctic experiences ahead.

DAY 7: ILULISSAT	BREAKFAST – DINNER
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Post breakfast, the day begins at a comfortable and unhurried pace, allowing you to truly absorb the serene beauty of Greenland. We join a breathtaking hike to Sermermiut, an ancient Inuit settlement dating back 4,400 years. Located within the protected UNESCO World Heritage Site near Ilulissat Icefjord, this remarkable place offers a unique blend of cultural history and stunning Arctic landscapes. As you walk through this historic site, you'll hear stories of the people who once lived here, all while taking in panoramic views of towering icebergs drifting through the fjord. It's an unforgettable experience that combines nature, history, and awe-inspiring scenery. Perfect for travellers seeking a deeper connection to Greenland's past and its majestic natural beauty.

We also take up a walking tour of **Ilulissat Old City center** with 300 years of fascinating history above the polar circle.

History, culture and nature are inseparable in Greenland – so even though you might primarily have come to Greenland to experience icebergs, whales and sled dogs, a city walk with us is still almost a necessity. Every time you see an iceberg in ten thousand indescribable shades of blue or a humpback whale, you will come to think of the city walk.

You will understand the enormous significance and impact the nature has in Greenlandic culture and history as well as for today's everyday life.

Next, The Icefjord Centre takes you on an extraordinary journey into Greenlandic nature and culture. The story of the ice is the story of life in **Disko Bay**. It is the story of the incredible weight of the ice sheet, which over the course of thousands of years crushes the bedrock and pushes it in front of itself, on its slow and irresistible journey to the sea. Ice also means life for the people and animals who need it for hunting or fishing. Here, the ice is the foundation of both nature and human life. Besides the permanent exhibition the Icefjord Centre accommodates art installations, a shop and a café where you can enjoy a coffee and a bite to eat while you take in the impressions of your visit.

Finally after we take dinner we set sail to witness the Aurora one last time by boat. This boat trip will take you into Disko Bay in the quest for the fascinating lights. By distancing you from the town, the experience of the northern lights will become more visible and clearer. You will be doing several stops to enjoy the sight of the

sky igniting in wavey shapes and colors in one of the most beautiful sky phenomena with icebergs sprouting in the background.

The Northern lights appear all year around, but due to the midnight sun the phenomenon can only be seen during the winter months in the Arctic Circle. The weather forecast must predict a clear sky in order to see the levitating lights. Therefore, we will only sail out if the weather allows it.

As the day comes to an end, you are left with a deeper appreciation of Greenland's fragile yet magnificent Arctic ecosystem, along with unforgettable memories of icefilled horizons, silent fjords, and the extraordinary landscapes that make Ilulissat one of the world's most remarkable destinations.

DAY 8: ILULISSAT - COPENHAGEN

BREAKFAST – PACKED
DINNER

Today after breakfast we check out and proceed towards the airport to catch a flight to Copenhagen.
Arrive at night in Copenhagen.

On arrival, take a packed dinner and transfer to the hotel for a comfortable overnight stay in the hotel.

DAY 9: COPENHAGEN - KOLKATA

BREAKFAST – MEALS ON BOARD

Have a relaxed breakfast in your hotel, later check out and transfer to the airport for the final departure.

DAY 10: KOLKATA

Arrive at Kolkata. Complete all the immigration formalities before leaving the airport. It is time to bid goodbye to all the friends you have met during the tour.
