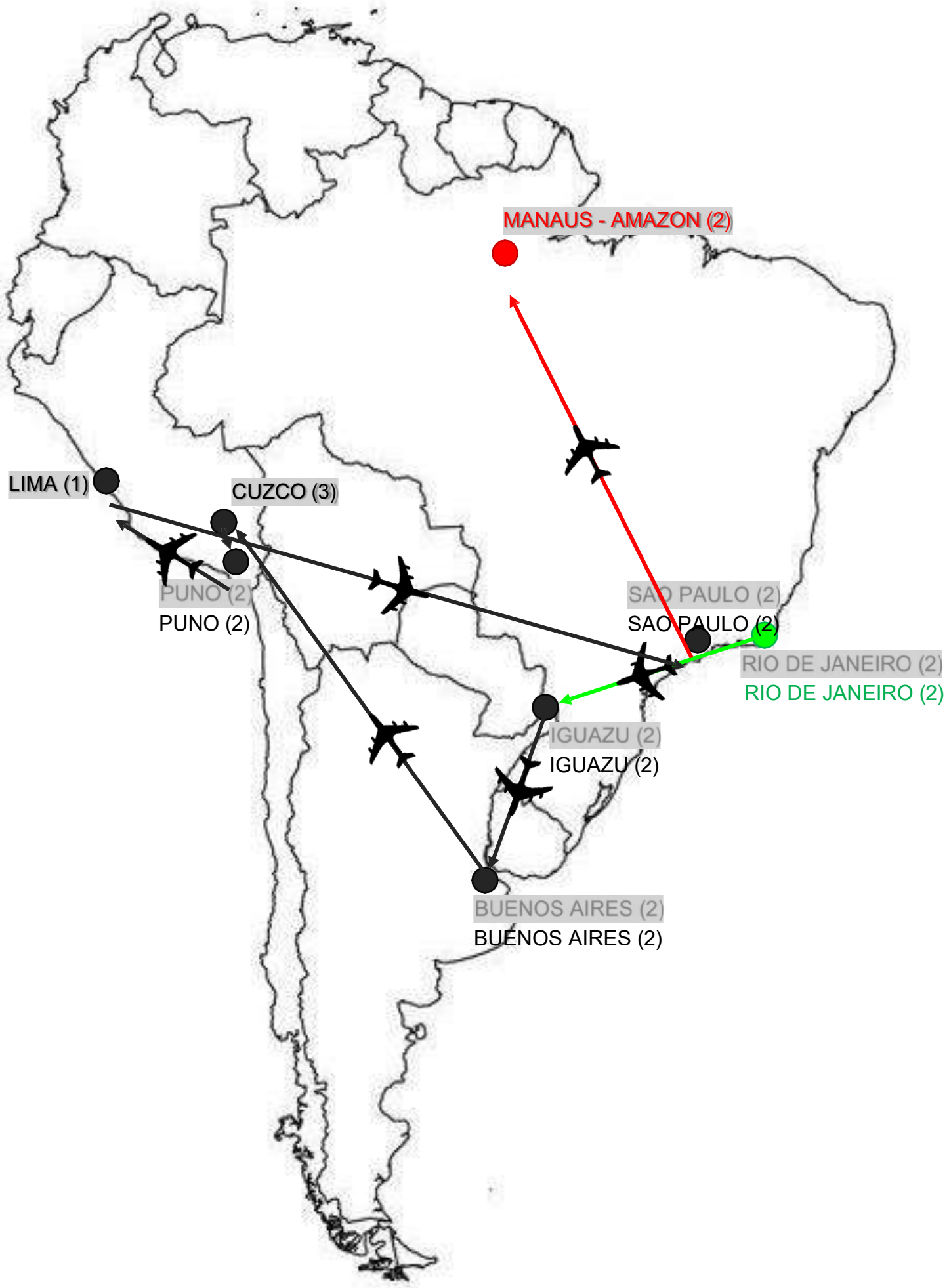

Day 1: KOLKATA - DUBAI	MEAL ON BOARD
------------------------	---------------

Day 2: DUBAI - RIO DE JANEIRO	MEAL ON BOARD – PACKED DINNER

Welcome to Rio de Janeiro, the lively and captivating “**Marvelous City**” of **Brazil**, famously known as **Cidade Maravilhosa**! Set against a stunning backdrop of verdant mountains and the shimmering Atlantic Ocean, Rio de Janeiro is among the most breathtaking destinations in the world. The city is celebrated for its spectacular natural beauty, sun-kissed beaches, vibrant cultural scene, infectious energy, and warm Brazilian hospitality.

Once the capital of Brazil until 1960, Rio de Janeiro continues to hold a special place as the country’s cultural and entertainment hub. The city is deeply associated with the rhythms of samba, the passion for football, and the internationally acclaimed **Rio Carnival**, one of the world’s biggest and most vibrant celebrations, attracting visitors with its colorful parades, music, dance, and festive atmosphere.

Upon arrival, complete the immigration and arrival formalities before proceeding with your transfer to the hotel. After check-in, enjoy ample leisure time to relax and explore the surroundings at your own pace. In the evening, take a leisurely stroll along the iconic **Copacabana Beach** and soak in the lively atmosphere while enjoying the beautiful coastal views. Later, return to the hotel for dinner and settle in for a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 3: RIO DE JANEIRO	BREAKFAST – DINNER
-----------------------	--------------------

After breakfast, set out to explore the vibrant city of Rio de Janeiro in greater detail, beginning with a memorable cruise across Guanabara Bay. This scenic boat ride offers a unique perspective of the city and its famous landmarks from the water. The cruise departs from Marina da Glória, providing wonderful views of Flamengo, Botafogo, Urca, Sugarloaf Mountain, and several beautiful beaches along the coastline. The boat excursion is scheduled to commence at 9:00 AM and will continue for approximately two hours.

Following the cruise, continue with an extensive sightseeing tour of historic Rio de Janeiro. Visit the impressive São Bento Monastery and the historic Candelaria Church, followed by Praça XV, Travessa do Mercado, and the Imperial Palace. Continue to the Cultural Centre housed in the beautifully restored Banco do Brasil building and explore Casa França-Brasil. The tour also takes you along Ouvidor Street and Gonçalves Dias Street, home to the iconic Colombo Coffee Shop, before continuing to Carioca Square and the magnificent Metropolitan Cathedral.

The sightseeing journey then proceeds towards Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas, a picturesque lagoon, before reaching the Rebouças Tunnel. Stretching approximately 2.6 kilometres, this impressive tunnel complex connects the southern and northern areas of Rio de Janeiro, passing through the Tijuca mountain ridge. This remarkable location highlights Rio's unique geographical setting, where a vast National Park is situated just

minutes away from the heart of the city.

Upon reaching the charming Cosme Velho district, board a Swiss-made cogwheel railway for a scenic ascent up the mountain. The train climbs from an elevation of approximately 15 metres to nearly 670 metres above sea level, taking you close to the summit of Corcovado Mountain. From the railway station, continue by climbing a series of steps to reach the base of the world-famous Christ the Redeemer statue.

Standing majestically above the city, the Christ the Redeemer statue is beautifully covered in soapstone mosaic and is regarded as one of Rio de Janeiro's most remarkable Art Nouveau monuments. From this elevated viewpoint, enjoy breathtaking panoramic vistas across the lush Tijuca National Forest, with a dramatic circle of mountains stretching towards the horizon and the magnificent Guanabara Bay visible in the distance.

In the afternoon, continue discovering the historic centre of Rio de Janeiro and explore the many landmarks that reflect the city's fascinating past. Rio has played an important role throughout Brazilian history, having served as the capital of Colonial Brazil, the capital of the Portuguese and Brazilian Empires, and later as the capital of the Republic. The numerous historical attractions visited during the tour represent these different eras and form an important part of Brazil's national heritage.

The day's sightseeing adventure concludes with a visit to Sugarloaf Mountain, one of Rio de Janeiro's most iconic landmarks and a true symbol of the city. Reaching the summit involves a spectacular two-stage cable car journey. The Italian-made cable cars accommodate approximately 80 passengers per trip, with each stage taking around two minutes

The first section takes you to Morro da Urca, which rises to approximately 170 metres above sea level. Here, you can enjoy facilities including a restaurant, amphitheatre, helipad for scenic flights, and magnificent views overlooking the Yacht Club and Botafogo Bay. The second cable car journey continues all the way to the summit of Sugarloaf Mountain, whose distinctive shape is traditionally associated with the loaves of sugar once commonly used by the Portuguese during the early period of the city's discovery.

At the summit, enjoy an unparalleled 360-degree panoramic view of Rio de Janeiro and its spectacular surroundings. The viewpoint offers one of the most impressive perspectives of the city and is particularly renowned for providing a complete view of the famous Copacabana Beach.

After completing the visit to Sugarloaf Mountain, return directly to the hotel. Upon arrival, take some time to freshen up, shower, and relax after an exciting day of sightseeing. Later, proceed to a local restaurant for dinner and enjoy a delightful meal before returning to the hotel for the night.

Day 4: RIO DE JANEIRO - IGUAZU

BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast today, we will board a flight to visit the Brazilian side of the magnificent **Iguazu Falls**. Straddling the border between Brazil and Argentina, Iguazu Falls is an awe-inspiring collection of approximately 275 individual cascades spread across nearly 2.7 kilometres (1.7 miles) along the Iguazu River. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this natural wonder is among the most spectacular and popular attractions in South America.

Our exploration today will focus on the Brazilian side of the falls, situated within the beautiful **Iguaçu National Park** in the state of **Paraná**. While the Argentinian side is renowned for its close and immersive encounters with the waterfalls, the Brazilian side offers breathtaking panoramic vistas, providing an opportunity to admire the vastness, power, and grandeur of the entire waterfall system from a wider perspective.

One of the most remarkable moments of the visit will be reaching the viewing platform that stretches out towards the legendary Devil's Throat, the largest and most powerful section of Iguazu Falls. Witness the immense volume of water cascading dramatically into the gorge below, accompanied by the roar of the falls, refreshing mist rising from the river, and, on favourable days, spectacular rainbows adding to the magical scenery.

Following our memorable experience on the Brazilian side, we will continue our journey by road towards the Argentinian side of Iguazu Falls. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and relax after an exciting day surrounded by one of nature's most extraordinary creations. Enjoy a comfortable overnight stay on the Argentinian side of the falls.

Day 5: IGUAZU

BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast, proceed for Iguazu boat ride. The Iguazú Falls in South America are heralded as the most dramatic and among the most monumental waterfalls in the world, tumbling over the cliffs on the border with the Argentine province of Misiones and Brazilian state of Paraná. Voted as **one of the New Seven Natural Wonders of the World**, the Iguazú Falls are undoubtedly the most visited place in Misiones and one of the most imposing natural attractions in the world. Consisting of a network of 275 waterfalls spanning an area of nearly 3 km wide, incredible vistas of the falls from virtually every angle in a 360° view takes your breath away.

Later, transfer to the restaurant for dinner. Return to the hotel and stay overnight in the hotel at Iguazu.

DAY 6: IGUAZU – BUENOS AIRES

BREAKFAST – DINNER

Today, after a delicious breakfast, we begin our exploration of Buenos Aires with an orientation tour of the city. The sophisticated capital of Argentina, Buenos Aires is often fondly referred to as the "**Paris of South America**." Renowned for its magnificent European-inspired architecture, colourful and lively neighbourhoods, fascinating history, passionate tango traditions, and exceptional culinary scene, the city is undoubtedly one of the most enchanting destinations in Latin America. During today's exploration, we will discover some of its most renowned landmarks and experience the unique character and charm that make Buenos Aires truly special.

Our first destination is **Plaza de Mayo**, the historic and political centre of Buenos Aires. Dating back to the city's foundation in 1580, this iconic square has played a significant role in many of Argentina's most important historical and political moments. Over the centuries, it has witnessed revolutions, presidential addresses, demonstrations, and countless events that have shaped the nation's history. Even today, Plaza de Mayo continues to serve as a significant meeting point and gathering space for residents and visitors alike. We then proceed to the vibrant and colourful neighbourhood of **La Boca**, one of the most iconic and photographed areas of Buenos Aires. Originally settled by Italian immigrants, this lively district is particularly famous for **Caminito Street**, where brightly coloured buildings, talented local artists, musicians, and passionate tango performers bring the streets to life. The neighbourhood beautifully showcases the city's immigrant roots, creative energy, and distinctive artistic character.

Our exploration continues towards **Puerto Madero**, the city's stylish and contemporary waterfront district. Once a neglected port area, Puerto Madero has undergone an impressive transformation and is now regarded as one of the most sophisticated parts of Buenos Aires. The area is lined with elegant residences, upscale restaurants, landscaped parks, and picturesque promenades, making it an ideal place to experience the modern side of the Argentine capital.

We next make our way to the elegant neighbourhood of **Recoleta**, celebrated for its refined Parisian-inspired architecture, sophisticated boutiques, charming cafés, and impressive cultural landmarks. One of its most renowned attractions is the historic Recoleta Cemetery, where magnificent marble mausoleums and elaborate tombs serve as the final resting places of several of Argentina's most distinguished personalities. Among the most famous is **Eva Perón**, affectionately remembered around the world as Evita, whose legacy remains deeply connected to the history and identity of Argentina.

Our city orientation concludes with a visit to Palermo, the largest and one of the most fashionable neighbourhoods in Buenos Aires. Often described as the green heart of the city, **Palermo** is renowned for its expansive parks, stylish cafés, designer boutiques, art galleries, and lively nightlife. Popular among both locals and visitors, this vibrant district perfectly combines natural beauty, contemporary culture, leisure, and the dynamic spirit of modern Buenos Aires.

Following our city orientation, we prepare for an enchanting evening featuring an unforgettable Tango Show at **La Ventana**, one of Buenos Aires' most authentic and renowned tango venues. Located in the historic neighbourhood of San Telmo, the oldest district of the city and an area widely associated with the origins of tango, La Ventana offers an atmosphere filled with the timeless charm of traditional Buenos Aires. With its

picturesque cobblestone streets, colonial-era architecture, antique stores, and inviting cafés, San Telmo continues to preserve the nostalgic character of the city's past.

Tonight's spectacular performance is far more than a traditional dance presentation; it is an immersive celebration of Argentina's rich cultural heritage and passionate artistic traditions. The show brings together a talented ensemble of professional tango dancers, accomplished singers, and a live musical orchestra, featuring the distinctive and evocative sound of the **bandoneón**, the instrument that has become an inseparable symbol of Argentine tango.

As the evening unfolds, sit back, relax, and allow the captivating music, graceful movements, passionate performances, and vibrant atmosphere to transport you into the heart and soul of Argentina. Complementing this extraordinary cultural experience will be a wholesome dinner, making the evening a truly memorable celebration of Buenos Aires, its traditions, and the timeless magic of tango.

Day 7: BUENOS AIRES – TIGRE DELTA	BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast, proceed for the tour to Delta of Tigre which is one of the vast regions covering 5405 square miles. The Tigre Delta is among the world’s largest and it is one of the only major deltas in the world that does not empty into a sea or ocean. It flows instead into the Río de la Plata, which separates Argentina and Uruguay, after the Río Paraná splits into several smaller rivers and forms a multitude of sedimentary islands covered in forest and grasslands. With its islands and canals, Tigre is what Venice might have looked like before development.

On arrival at Tigre, view the most amazing panoramic view of the exotic Delta of Parana River formed by thousands of islets and huge area of subtropical forests. Enjoy one hour boat tour in this delta.

Later, return to Buenos Aires followed by dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 8: BUENOS AIRES - CUZCO	BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast, proceed to the airport to board the flight to Cuzco. On arrival, transfer to the hotel for check-in followed by dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 9: CUZCO	BREAKFAST – PACKED LUNCH - DINNER

After breakfast, proceed for The **Rainbow Mountain**, or Vinicunca, is an astonishing natural phenomenon in Cusco, Peru. This impressive landscape has become one of the country's most popular tourist destinations due to its uniqueness and unparalleled beauty. What makes this mountain so special is its extraordinary color palettes.

Later, we will proceed for the city tour of Cuzco, the religious and administrative capital of the **Inca Empire** which flourished in ancient Peru between c. 1400 and 1534 CE. The **Incas** controlled territory from Quito to Santiago, making theirs the largest empire ever seen in the Americas and the largest in the world at that time.

Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Cuzco.

Day 10: MACHU PICCHU	BREAKFAST – LUNCH - DINNER
----------------------	-------------------------------

After breakfast, proceed towards Machu Picchu for a guided tour by train. More than 7,000 feet above sea level in the Andes Mountains, Machu Picchu is the most visited tourist destination in Peru. A symbol of the Incan Empire and built around 1450AD, Machu Picchu was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1983 and was named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World in 2007. It is a 15th-century Inca citadel situated on a mountain ridge 2,430 metres(7,970 feet) above sea level. Machu Picchu was built in the classical Inca style, with polished dry-stone walls. Its three primary structures are the *Inti Watana*, the *Temple of the Sun*, and the *Room of the Three Window*.

Later, return to Cuzco, have dinner and stay overnight in the hotel.

Day 11: CUZCO - PUNO	BREAKFAST – DINNER
----------------------	--------------------

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel at Cuzco and proceed to Puno. With a regal plaza, concrete-block buildings and crumbling bricks that blend into the hills, Puno has its share of both grit and cheer. It serves as the jumping-off point for Lake Titicaca and is a convenient stop for those traveling between Cuzco and La Paz. But it may just capture your heart with its own rickety charm.

On arrival at Puno, have dinner and stay overnight in the hotel at Puno.

Day 12: LAKE TITICACA – UROS ISLAND - PUNO

BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast, proceed to Lake Titicaca. Astonishment awaits on a trip to Lake Titicaca. Lake Titicaca is a large, deep lake in the Andes on the border of Peru and Bolivia. By volume of water and by surface area, it is the largest lake in South America. It is often called the "Highest Navigable Lake" in the world, with a surface elevation of 3,812 metres (12,507 ft). Its mystical waters are home to diverse Andean communities and a hot-spot for some of Peru's largest festivals. Lake Titicaca is the world's highest navigable lake and one of South America's stunning natural wonders. The deep blue of the water seems to meld with the sky and a ring of snow-tipped peaks creates the remarkable sensation of floating atop the earth's highest elevations.

Lake Titicaca tour takes you first to Uros Islands which are composed of about 32 islands constructed of many layers of totora reeds woven into thick mats. In the case of the Uros, the reed islands are woven by hand and float upon the surface of the lake. Take an exciting boat ride in Lake Titicaca - the largest lake in South America.

Later, drive back to Puno, have dinner and stay overnight.

Day 13: PUNO - LIMA

BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast, we check out from the hotel and proceed to the airport to board our flight to Lima, the vibrant and culturally rich capital of Peru. Often referred to as the "**City of Kings**" or "**La Ciudad de los Reyes**," Lima was established by the Spanish conquistador Francisco Pizarro on 18 January 1535. Today, with a population of more than 10 million, the city serves as the political, cultural, financial, and gastronomic heart of **Peru**.

Located along the Pacific coastline, Lima is a captivating destination where the remnants of ancient civilizations blend beautifully with Spanish colonial heritage and contemporary city life. Upon arrival, we begin our sightseeing with a visit to the **Historic Centre of Lima**, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1988. As we explore this fascinating part of the city, we will come across impressive colonial-era buildings, intricately carved wooden balconies, magnificent churches, and elegant plazas that reflect Lima's rich Spanish colonial past.

Our sightseeing tour takes us first to the **Plaza Mayor**, also known as the Plaza de Armas, regarded as the historic birthplace and symbolic heart of Lima. It was here that Francisco Pizarro officially founded the city almost five centuries ago. Over the years, the plaza has played an important role in Peru's history and has been the setting for numerous significant events, ranging from grand colonial ceremonies to lively modern celebrations.

The Plaza Mayor is surrounded by several remarkable landmarks and historically significant buildings. Among them is the Government Palace, which serves as the official residence and workplace of the President of Peru. We will also admire the magnificent **Cathedral of Lima**, an impressive architectural masterpiece showcasing Renaissance and Baroque influences. The cathedral is also renowned for housing the tomb of Francisco Pizarro.

Our exploration of Lima continues with a visit to the **Larco Museum**, one of the country's most distinguished and renowned museums. The museum provides an extraordinary opportunity to discover the fascinating history and cultural heritage of Peru, with an extensive collection that traces nearly 5,000 years of Peruvian civilization. Whether you have a passion for history or are simply interested in learning about ancient cultures, a visit to the Larco Museum offers an enriching and memorable experience.

After completing our sightseeing, we proceed to the hotel and settle in for the evening. Later, enjoy a delicious dinner before relaxing and spending the night at the hotel, bringing an enriching day of exploring Lima to a comfortable close.

Day 14: LIMA – SAO PAULO

BREAKFAST – DINNER

After breakfast, transfer to Lima airport to board the flight to Sao Paulo.
After dinner, proceed to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 15: SAO PAULO

BREAKFAST – DINNER

On arrival, proceed for a city tour of San Paolo - the biggest city in South America and the Southern Hemisphere and the second biggest city in the Western Hemisphere (after Mexico City). It is also the city of soccer where the gala event of 2014 World Cup Football Tournament held. After having dinner overnight stay at hotel in Sao Paulo.

Day 16: SAO PAULO – MANAUS - AMAZON

BREAKFAST – LUNCH – LOCAL DINNER

Today, packed breakfast will be served. Check-out of the hotel and transfer to Sao Paulo Airport.

Arrive at Manaus pier and enjoy the speed boat ride in Amazon to the other side of the river, passing the point at which the Negro river and the Solimoes River flow into one another. The Amazon Basin supports the world's largest rainforest, which accounts for more than half the total volume of rainforests in the world. Occupying much of Brazil and Peru, and also parts of Guyana, Colombia, Ecuador, Bolivia, Suriname, French Guiana, and Venezuela, the Amazon River Basin is the world's largest drainage system.

Embark on a spectacular tour down the river and observe pink and grey river dolphins floating by, as well as various wildlife including monkeys, sloths and snakes.

Enjoy dinner in the lodge itself in the rainforest.

Later, check-in to the lodge after dinner & stay overnight at Amazon.

Day 17: AMAZON

BREAKFAST – LUNCH - LOCAL DINNER

After breakfast, proceed for the Amazon Rainforest tour by foot. In Amazon Rainforest, one might experience lots of predators and birds, which includes on the surface, bullet ant, vampire bat, brazilian spider, scarlet macaws, amazon kingfisher, yellow headed caracara, etc. and in the water, electric eel, red piranha, poison dart frog, blue shark, pit vipers etc.

Note: You can opt for an optional tour to witness the confluence of Nigro and Amazon River

After the tour, return to the hotel after dinner for an overnight stay at Amazon.

Day 18: AMAZON – MANAUS – SAO PAULO

BREAKFAST – MEAL ON BOARD

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel and transfer to Manaus airport by speedboat.

Reach Sao Paulo and wait for your flight to Dubai.

Day 19: SAO PAULO - DUBAI

MEAL ON BOARD

Board the connecting flight from Dubai to reach Kolkata. Complete all the immigration formalities before leaving for Kolkata.

Day 20: KOLKATA

Arrive at Kolkata.

Bid good-bye to all the friends you have met during the tour.
